Erasmus+ Study Mobility allows to study abroad at any of Riseba partner institutions for a semester or full academic year. Erasmus + traineeship mobility allows to gain professional experience by participating in a traineeship with a company in the host country. **This is a great opportunity to experience a new culture, learn a new language, and gain valuable skills that will benefit your future career.**

Easy application process: Submit an application online

Selection Criteria: Average mark 7 or above, No academic and financial debts, English language proficiency at least at B2 level. Bachelor students must have completed first year of studies, master students- 1st semester before going abroad.

- Students can study abroad for a semester or a full academic year and/or also can complete internships abroad for a minimum of 2 months and maximum of 12 months.

(The same student may receive grants for mobility periods totalling 12 months maximum per each study cycle (bachelor, master's, PhD) no matter the number or type of mobility)

- Erasmus+ provides financial support for students to help cover the costs of their mobility, including travel, accommodation, and subsistence (the average monthly scholarship 700 euros)
