## **ADMISSION REGULATIONS (for the academic year 2026/2027)**

### **Terms Used**

**Applicant** – person applying for the study place announced by RISEBA University of Applied Sciences (hereinafter – referred to as RISEBA University).

**First cycle** – studies in academic or professional Bachelor's programme.

**Second cycle** – studies in academic or professional Master's study programme.

**Third cycle** – doctoral studies.

**Additional admission** – admission to available study places after the competition deadline.

**Study agreement on acquisition of education** – contract being concluded between the RISEBA University and applicant for studies.

**Electronic application** – applying for programmes using RISEBA University's internal information system my.riseba.lv (RIS).

**Matriculation** - enrolment of the applicant in the university's student register by fulfilling all the admissions requirements of RISEBA University, signing the study agreement and paying the first study fee.

**Profiling study subjects** – study subjects whose final marks are taken into account when calculating the competition level in the specific core programme.

**Registration fee** – payment for submission and examination of documents.

### **1. General Issues**

1.1. Admission regulations determine the procedure for admitting applicants to RISEBA University's first, second and third cycle study programmes.

1.2. Admission regulations are developed in accordance with Paragraph 46 of the Law of Higher Education, October 10, 2006, Cabinet of Ministers Regulations No. 846 "Regulations Regarding the Requirements, Criteria and Procedures for Admission to Study Programmes and State Support for Citizens who have Volunteered for and Completed National Defence Service" and the Study regulation of RISEBA University.

1.3. The right to study at the RISEBA University is granted to every Latvian citizen and Latvian non-citizen as well as a foreign national. In order to study in a higher education institution, a previous education attested by documents, recognised in Latvia and compliant with the requirements of the study programme shall be required. A citizen of Latvia, a non-citizen of Latvia, a citizen of the European Union, a citizen of the European Economic Area or a citizen of the Swiss Confederation and a permanent resident of the European Community who has a valid residence permit has equal rights to study in a higher education institution or college. Foreigners who apply for distance learning studies do not need permanent or temporary residence permits.

1.4. For foreign students, in accordance with Section 56 of the Law on Higher Education Institutions, the mandatory curriculum must include the acquisition of the state language if the studies in Latvia are expected to last longer than six months or exceed 30 credit points.

1.5. RISEBA University offers a wide range of discounts on the tuition fee for applicants (view *the Regulation on the Granting of RISEBA-Funded Budget Places and Tuition Fee Discounts* attachment).

1.6. Applicants, who complied with all the requirements of the Admission Regulations, were accepted by the Admission Commission, concluded their study contract and have paid the first study fee are matriculated in the study programme.

1.7. The admission of applicants to RISEBA University is organized by an Admissions Commission appointed by the Rector's ordinance, which operates in accordance with the regulations of the Admissions Commission.

1.8. All information about the admission process, the selection criteria and admission requirements for applicants is available on the RISEBA University website – [www.riseba.lv](http://www.riseba.lv).

1.9. The regulation and amendments are approved by the Senate of RISEBA University.

1.10. RISEBA University ensures the registration of applicants and their admission is organised all year round with studies starting in the fall or spring semester, in accordance with the deadlines set by the university Rector's ordinance (information about study programmes offered during the summer and winter intakes is available on the website – [www.riseba.lv](http://www.riseba.lv)).

## 2. Applying and registering for studies

2.1. Applicants are admitted in the following study programmes:

2.1.1. **First cycle academic** bachelor's study programmes;

2.1.1.1. **Architecture** (in English);

2.1.1.2. **Business Psychology** (in Latvian and English);

2.1.1.3. **Audiovisual Arts and Media Arts** (in Latvian and English);

2.1.1.3.1. Specialisation *Film Cinematographer* (at the time of issuing the admission regulations, changes are being made to the specialization name, after their approval, the specialization name will be as follows: "Film and Multimedia Producer");

2.1.1.3.2. Specialisation *Film Producer* (at the time of issuing the admission regulations, changes are being made to the specialization name; after their approval, the specialization name will be as follows: "Film and Multimedia Cinematographer");

2.1.1.3.3. Specialisation *Film Director* (at the time of issuing the admission regulations, changes are being made to the specialization name; after their approval, the specialization name will be as follows: "Film and Multimedia Director");

2.1.1.3.4. Specialisation *Audiovisual Journalist*.

2.1.2. **First cycle professional** bachelor's study programmes:

2.1.2.1. **European Business Studies** (English);

2.1.2.1.1. Qualification – Business Manager.

2.1.2.2. **Public Relations and Advertising Management** (in Latvian and English);

2.1.2.2.1. Sub-programme: Public Relations; qualification – Public Relations Manager;

2.1.2.2.2. Sub-programme: Advertising; qualification – Advertising Manager.

2.1.2.3. **Business Management** (in Latvian and English).

2.1.2.3.1. Specialisation: Business Management; qualification – Business Manager,

2.1.2.3.2. Specialisation: Business Management in Digital Environment; qualification – E-Business Manager.

2.1.3. **Second cycle academic master's programmes:**

2.1.3.1. **New Media and Audiovisual Art** (in English) (*At the time of issuing the admission regulations, changes are being made to the study programme, transitioning from a jointly implemented study programme to an independently implemented study programme, and after their approval, the following study programme name is planned to be: "Audiovisual and Immersive Technology Art", and it is also being planned to implement the*

*study programme in Latvian, harmonizing the names of such specializations, which will come into effect after their approval):*

- 2.1.3.1.1. Specialisation: *Digital storytelling and interactive narratives in audiovisual media art;*
  - 2.1.3.1.2. Specialisation: *Immersive Technologies in Audiovisual Media Arts (Augmented Reality (XR) Art, Artificial Intelligence, and Game Design)*

  - 2.1.3.3. **Health Management** (in Latvian and English).
  - 2.1.4. **Second cycle professional** master's study programmes:

    - 2.1.4.3. **International Business** (in English);

    - 2.1.4.4. **Project Management** (in Latvian);
      - 2.1.4.4.1. Qualification – Project Manager.
    - 2.1.4.5. **Human Resource Management** (in Latvian);
      - 2.1.4.5.1. Qualification – Organisation Manager.
    - 2.1.4.6. **Management Psychology and Supervision** (in Latvian);
      - 2.1.4.6.1. Qualification – Supervisor.
    - 2.1.4.7. **Strategic Business Management** (in Latvian);
    - 2.1.4.8. **Sports Management** (in Latvian and English);
      - 2.1.4.8.1. Qualification – Organisation Manager.
  - 2.1.5. **Third cycle** joint Doctor's programme:
    - 2.1.5.1. **Joint study programme Business Management** (English);
    - 2.1.5.2. **Media Arts and Creative Technologies** (in English) *at the time of issuing the admission regulations, changes are being made to the study programme, transitioning from a jointly implemented study programme to an independently implemented study programme.*
- 2.2. When registering, applicants shall submit documents recognized in Latvia, which confirm that the applicant has completed secondary or higher education, and the documents necessary for enrollment as stipulated in this regulation and its appendices, take the any entrance exams if necessary and shall pay the registration fee, presenting the payment order – EUR 40.00 or EUR 200.00 (foreigners). For foreigners who have obtained their previous education at RISEBA University, i.e. Vocational Secondary School VICTORIA, or are graduates of RISEBA University undergraduate programmes, the registration fee for the next study level is EUR 50.00. The registration fee is non-refundable.
- 2.3. The applicant submits the original documents in person. If the applicant is unable to submit the documents personally, they may be submitted by another person who presents a notarized power of attorney or who has previously issued verbal authorization from the applicant on site at RISEBA University.
- 2.4. Applicants register for studies electronically via my.riseba.lv (RIS). No later than at the moment of signing the study agreement - and earlier if requested by the Admissions Commission - the electronic application must be confirmed by personally arriving at the RISEBA Admissions Office and presenting an identity document as well as the originals of the documents certifying general secondary or professional secondary education.
- 2.5. Admission **requirements** for **first cycle** study programmes:
- 2.5.1. obtained secondary education (corresponds to the fourth level of the Latvian Qualifications Framework);
  - 2.5.2. passed the centralized examination in Latvian;
  - 2.5.3. passed the centralized examination in Mathematics;

- 2.5.4. passed the centralised examination in English;
  - 2.5.5. English knowledge equivalent to or above the B2 level, if applying for studies in English;
  - 2.5.6. in accordance with paragraph 2.11 of the Admission Regulations – passed the entrance examination for the relevant study programmes.
- 2.6. For individuals who obtained their secondary education before 2004 or have received an exemption from taking the centralized exams, which is confirmed by an entry in the secondary education transcript of records, compliance with the requirements described in paragraphs 2.5.2. – 2.5.4. of the Admission Regulations can be proven with passing grades from the relevant subjects found on the secondary education certificate (*in accordance with the formulated “Equivalent evaluations of RISEBA University” from the section “Applying and registering for studies” of the Admission Regulations*).
- 2.7. For applicants who have finished their secondary education abroad, the requirements described in paragraphs 2.5.2. – 2.5.4. of the Admission Regulations are replaced by successfully completing the **RISEBA Admission test** (see Appendix 20).
- 2.8. Compliance with the requirements described in paragraphs 2.5.2. – 2.5.4. of the Admission Regulations may be proven by a certificate from an international institution – IELTS, TOEFL, PTE Academic, Cambridge English or ECL English or other test results in accordance with December 20, 2022 Cabinet of Ministers Regulations No. 795 *Regulation on Replacement of the Foreign Language Examination in the General Secondary Education Programme with an International Testing Institution Foreign Language Test* (see Appendices 21 and 22), which has been obtained within the last two years.
- 2.9. Alongside the centralized exam results mentioned in paragraph 2.5.4., which corresponds to the B2 level, and alongside the other test results described in paragraph 2.8., which correspond to the B2 level, compliance with the requirements described in paragraph 2.5.5. of the Admission Regulations may be confirmed by:
- 2.9.1. a document confirming that the medium of instruction in the applicant’s prior education was English;
  - 2.9.2. a successfully completed RISEBA English language entrance examination.
- 2.10. Applicant admission in the first-cycle (Bachelor’s level) study programmes take place on a basis of competition, taking into account the average score of the central examination (CE) in percentage and the average grade of the profiling subjects defined for each study programme. The competition criteria are indicated for study programme on the Admission Regulations Appendices, but they are applied in this order:
- 2.10.1. Result of an entrance examination or total of results (if the admission requirements of the study programme stipulate passing an entrance examination(s));
  - 2.10.2. the average grade from the profiling subjects defined for each study programme;
  - 2.10.3. results of centralized exams (in Latvian, English and Mathematics) according to the proportion specified in the Appendices of the Admission Regulations or grades in the relevant subjects seen on the certificate (in the case specified in paragraph 2.6. of the Admission Regulations), or the result of the **RISEBA Admission test** (in the case specified in paragraph 2.7. of the Admission Regulations).
- 2.11. Entrance examinations are prescribed for the **admission** of applicants to the following **first-cycle** study programmes:
- 2.11.1. **Entrance examination in drawing and composition in bachelor's study programme Architecture.** The conditions of the entrance examination are stipulated in the *Regulations on the Entrance Examination in Drawing and Composition*. The entrance examination in drawing and composition is not required for applicants who have completed the RISEBA University pre-training course in drawing and composition and have passed the final examination.

2.11.2. **bachelor's study programme Audiovisual Arts and Media Arts:**

2.11.2.1. **Entrance examination on creativity.** The requirements of the entrance examination are stipulated in the *Regulations on the Entrance Examination in Audio Visual Arts and Media Arts*. Applicants must write an essay (selecting one of several proposed topics) at RISEBA University.

2.11.2.2. **Entrance examination – colloquium.** The requirements of the entrance examination are stipulated in the *Regulations on the Entrance Examination in Audiovisual Arts and Media Arts*. Applicants are invited to interviews with the Head of the academic field, or the Programme Director or the Dean of the Faculty.

2.12. For **admission** into **first-cycle** study programmes applicants compete with the results of the centralized exams and or the grades from the relevant subjects found on their secondary education certificate (in the case specified in paragraph 2.6. of the Admission Regulations), or results from the **RISEBA Admission test** (in the case specified in paragraph 2.7. of the Admission Regulations) and any other entrance examination results (if specified).

2.13. In the calculation of the competition rank, the CE results are used in accordance with the level coefficients established in the Cabinet of Ministers Regulation No 846 of 10 October 2006 "Regulations Regarding the Requirements, Criteria and Procedures for Admission to Study Programmes and State Support for Citizens who have Volunteered for and Completed National Defence Service":

2.13.1. A coefficient of 0.75 is applied to the exams for the optimal level of curriculum mastery.

2.13.2. A coefficient of 0.50 is applied to the exams for the general level of curriculum mastery.

2.13.3. The results of the centralized exams (CE) obtained in accordance with the regulations that were in effect until the enactment of the Cabinet of Ministers Regulation No. 416 "Regulations on the State General Secondary Education Standard and Sample General Secondary Education Programs" of September 3, 2019, and Cabinet of Ministers Regulation No. 332 "Regulations on the State Vocational Secondary Education Standard and the State Vocational Education Standard Samples" of June 2, 2020, are equated to the exams for the optimal level of curriculum mastery and a coefficient of 0.75 is applied to them.

For the centralized exam to be considered passed, the minimum acceptable score is:  
 10% - for those, who took the centralized examination in the 2022./2023. academic year,  
 15% - for those, who took the centralized examination in the 2023./2024. academic year,  
 20% - for those, who took the centralized examination in the 2024./2025. academic year,  
 20% - for those, who took the centralized examination in the 2025./2026. academic year.

2.14. The general admission **requirements** for **second or third cycle** (master's or doctoral level) study programmes:

2.14.1. First-cycle higher education (corresponding to the sixth level of the Latvian Qualifications Framework) in the fields specified in the appendix to the Admission Regulations for the relevant second-cycle study programme and its implementation method. Second-cycle higher education (corresponding to the seventh level of the Latvian Qualifications Framework) in the fields specified in the appendix to the Admission Regulations for the relevant third-cycle study programme and its implementation method. In addition to the requirement for prior education in a specific study programme, a requirement for professional experience may also be specified;

2.14.2. English knowledge equivalent to or above the B2 level, if applying for studies in English;

2.14.3. Obtained a passing grade on the entrance examination (if the Admissions Regulations appendix specifies an entrance examination for the relevant study programme).

2.15. Compliance with the requirements described in paragraph 2.14.2. of the Admission Regulations may be confirmed with:

2.15.1. a certificate from an international institution – IELTS, TOEFL, PTE Academic, Cambridge English or ECL English or other test results in accordance with December 20, 2022 Cabinet of Ministers Regulations No. 795 *Regulation on Replacement of the Foreign Language Examination in the General Secondary Education Programme with an International Testing Institution Foreign Language Test* (see Appendices 21 and 22), which has been obtained within the last two years;

2.15.2. a document confirming that the medium of instruction in the applicant's prior education was English;

2.15.3. a successfully completed English language entrance examination;

2.15.4. the knowledge and skills of the English language demonstrated during the admission process, interview or discussion.

2.16. Applicants are admitted to **second or third cycle** (master's or doctoral level) study programmes by determining the applicant's compliance with the admission requirements and the competition criteria set out in the programmes specified in the Appendices to the Admission Regulations.

2.17. When registering for **second-cycle** studies, the documents mentioned in Appendices 7–17, a copy of the bachelor's degree diploma and its supplement must be submitted. Applicants register for studies electronically at my.riseba.lv (RIS). No later than the moment of signing the study contract, but sooner if requested by the Admissions Commission, the electronic application must be approved by personally coming to the RISEBA Admissions Department, bringing with them the originals of their personal identification documents and educational documents.

- 2.18. When registering for **second-cycle** studies, persons who have obtained a bachelor's degree in other areas of science (not in social or other related sciences), if necessary, must complete the compensatory study course module in the amount of 10 CP (introductory module) before the start of studies or during the first year of study. The necessity for the introductory module and the scope of the courses in CP are evaluated by the relevant study programme director, depending on the previously acquired educational content and professional work experience
- 2.19. When registering for **second-cycle** studies, persons, who have not completed the courses “*Civil Protection*” and “*Environmental Protection*” at the previous level of studies, have to complete these courses as listeners, in line with the requirements of the *Civil Protection Law and the Environmental Protection Law*.
- 2.20. When registering for **third-cycle** studies, the documents referred to in Appendices 18. and 19. must be submitted.
- 2.21. For registration for part-time studies – **distance learning** while being abroad, applicants must use the electronic application system RIS and must attach the notarized copies of the educational documents or document originals (by filling in the electronic application in advance) or the original documents are presented to the representative of RISEBA University, using a video call and following and executing all instructions and requests regarding the authentication of the document.
- 2.22. If there has been a change in the applicants' surname, and the surname in the submitted documents differs from the one indicated in the applicant's identity document, a document confirming the surname change must be submitted in addition to the required documents.
- 2.23. For **admission** into any **cycle** study programme, if the applicant is unable to prove the requirement regarding English language proficiency at B2 level, the University organizes the opportunity to take the **English Language entrance examination**. The entrance examination conditions are regulated by the *English Language Entrance Examination Regulations*.
- 2.24. The knowledge of foreign applicants must meet the requirements of the RISEBA University Admission Regulations.
- 2.25. Foreign applicants who are not citizens of the European Union must have an average grade of at least 60% of the maximum possible grade in their previous education in order to be eligible for admission to higher education programmes. The university evaluates the applicant's previous education documents, and for recognition, including further admission, the documents of those persons whose average grade is less than 60% of the maximum possible grade are not forwarded. If the applicant referred to in this paragraph applies for admission to a study programme at a level at which he or she has already obtained higher education (for example, applies for a bachelor's study programme and has already obtained another bachelor's degree, or applies for a master's study programme and already has a master's degree in another programme), the higher education institution may take into account the average grade of the previously acquired education with the highest results in calculating the minimum average grade (in this case, for recognition, including for the further admission process, both the personal documents confirming compliance with the admission requirements and those confirming the previously acquired higher education in the same cycle for which the applicant is applying are submitted).
- 2.26. In order to assess the foreign entrant's motivation to study in the chosen study programme, RISEBA University conducts an interview with the foreign applicant and records the interview in a video format.
- 2.27. If the applicant has acquired previous education or degrees abroad, the educational documents must be accompanied by a statement from the Academic Information Center on the recognition of education and equalization with the level of education in Latvia.

- 2.28. **For foreign applicants** who are not EU/EEA or Swiss Confederation nationals, in addition to the documents to be submitted, a temporary residence permit in the Republic of Latvia must be submitted, except for foreign entrants who are applying for studies in distance learning. Foreign entrants from EU/EEA countries and the Swiss Confederation must register with the Office of Citizenship and Migration Affairs within 3 months if the foreign national will stay in Latvia for more than 3 months.
- 2.29. Application for the studies in the later stages of the study process (1<sup>st</sup> course 2<sup>nd</sup> semester, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup> course) takes place in accordance with the Law on Higher Education, RISEBA University Constitution and other legal documents, including the RISEBA University *Regulations Regarding Initiation of Studies in the Later Stages of Studies*.
- 2.30. If, upon registering for studies, the applicant wishes to assess and recognise the competencies he/she has acquired through previous professional experience outside of formal education or as a result of daily training, the applicant shall submit documents confirming the acquisition of these competencies in accordance with Cabinet of Ministers Regulation No.505 or 14 August 2018 “Rules for the Recognising the Knowledge, Skills, and Competences Acquired Outside Formal Education or Obtained by Professional Experience”.

### 3. Admission results and enrolment

- 3.1. Admission results shall be determined and approved by the Admissions Commission. Admission results are announced within five days after the competition closing date.
- 3.2. Based on the results of the competition, the applicants shall sign a study agreement on acquisition of education with RISEBA University within the specified period.
- 3.3. If the applicant does not sign a study agreement on acquisition of education within the specified period without a valid reason (they have not coordinated their arrival time with the Admissions Commission), the study place is offered to the next applicant according to the results of the competition.
- 3.4. The applicants are registered (matriculated) in the student list of RISEBA University with the Rector's ordinance when they:
- a) have passed the competition and/or passed the entrance examinations;
  - b) have paid the registration fee;
  - c) have concluded the study agreement on obtaining education.
  - d) have made the first study fee payment.
- 3.5. The number of places in each programme, form, and department is determined annually by the Rector's ordinance.
- 3.6. If the number of applicants applied for the study programme is less than the specified number of study places in the ordinance, RISEBA University may open additional admission.
- 3.7. The Admissions Commission decisions on the competition results can be appealed within 3 working days, submitting an application to RISEBA University Rector. The decision taken by the RISEBA University Rector can be appealed in the Court in the order specified in the Administrative Procedure Law.
